## Rialto's RSE approach



#### What is the RSE approach?

The RSE, (the Social Responsibility of Companies) is a company's approach to the challenges of sustainable development.

As our hotel evolves, we offer a RSE approach in order to educate our staff and customers but also to have a positive impact on the environment.

### Our RSE Improvements

#### Food waste:

• We propose to reduce food portions and serve meal sizes according to appetite. Our menus cater for "small or large hunger" in order to reduce food waste.

#### Sustainable supplies:

 We have opted for local products (honey from Tarn, Bonne Maman jam made in Briars sur Cère in the Lot region, goat cheese from Carmaux, organic quinoa from Berry etc.)

#### **SHORT STORY**

We have decided to highlight Quinoa du Berry because the producers are passionate farmers and are our daughter and son-in-law. Their company Sa Majesté La Graine has continued to develop since 2014 to offer customers quinoa, spelt, peas, chickpeas, coral lentils...all organic...

- Our welcome products, namely our soaps, shower gels and toilet paper, are environmentally friendly and ecological.
- Since 2019 we have implemented a ZERO chemical product approach in our hotel. Instead we use ozonated water, a powerful and ecological disinfectant, to clean all our surfaces.

We promote products from local and French suppliers and support local employment.



#### The management of our waste:

- We have set up a waste sorting system for our hoteliestaurant with several different bins. We deposit our waste at the recycling center in compliance with the RSE approach.
- Our food waste (bread, leftover vegetables) are given to staff to feed their pets.

Our goal is to replace our paper cups with glass containers thus reducing our environmental impact.

#### **Biodiversity:**

- In order to preserve biodiversity, we practice responsible mowing. No phytosanitary product is used in our garden.
- We collect rainwater to water our plants.

#### **Good pratices for our hotel:**

- When you leave, be sure to turn off the lights, the television, heating or air conditioning.
- o During a long stay, be aware that the sheets are changed every 5 nights. If you want it to be done earlier, please ask at the reception desk.

During periods of high heat we close the shutters rooms to keep the rooms cool.

Our upstairs bedrooms are air-conditioned and we leave it to our customers to activate the air conditioning upon arrival.
